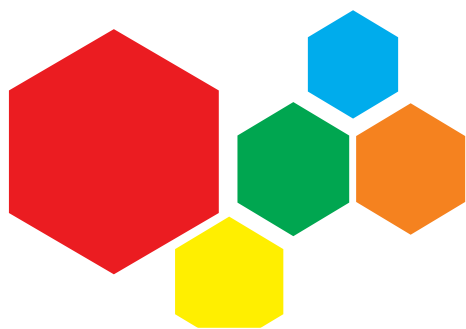

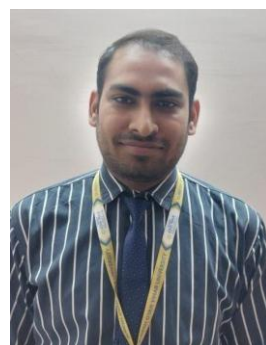

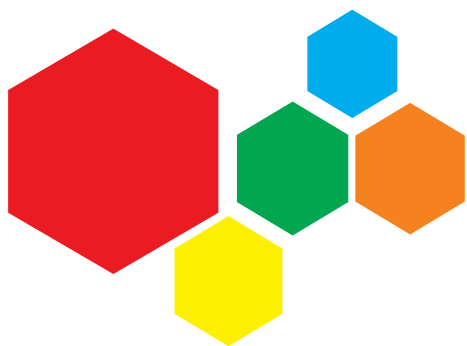

About Us

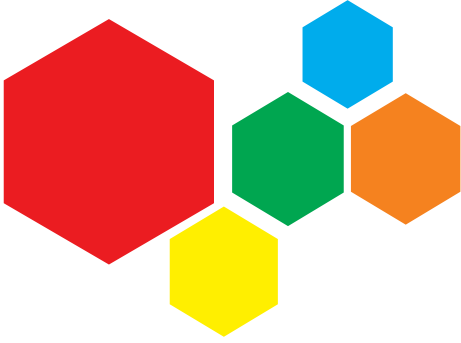
