

1. ADMISSION UNDER INTER UNIVERSITY MIGRATION:-

Inter University Migration for providing migration option to students who have partly completed their any UG / PG programme from any recognized University / College:

Eligibility:

Any candidate who is enrolled in any UG/PG programme of any university/Institution duly established by law, may be allowed to migrate in equivalent **SGVU** programme at any stage provided he/she fulfills the following criteria/conditions:-

- (a) The candidate possesses minimum qualification in the qualifying examination at par with other students admitted to the programme in which migration entry has been sought.
- (b) The candidate should not have any backlog.
- (c) **70%** of the courses (in terms of content) are common in the program of parent institution and **SGVU**.
- (d) The parent university/Institution has no objection in his/her migration.
- (e) The candidate possesses good moral character.

The application will be scrutinize by a committee for admission recommendation.

2. ADMISSION UNDER LATERAL ENTRY

(a) B. Tech (Engineering & Technology)

Eligibility:

- a. Passed Diploma examination with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in appropriate branch of Engineering and Technology.
- b. Passed B.Sc. Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) and passed 10+2 examination with Mathematics as a subject.
- c. Provided that the students belonging to B.Sc. Stream, shall clear the subjects Engineering Graphics/ Engineering Drawing and Engineering Mechanics of the First Year Engineering Programme along with the Second year subjects.
- d. Provided that the students belonging to B.Sc. Stream shall be considered only after filling the supernumerary seats in this category with students belonging to the Diploma stream.
- e. Passed D.Voc. Stream in the same or allied sector.

(b) MCA

Eligibility:

Passed in BCA, B.Sc. (IT/ Computer Science) with Mathematics as a Course at 10+2 level or at the Graduation Level.

Obtained at least 50% marks (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying Examination.

(c) B. PHARMACY

Eligibility:

Passed Diploma examination in a Programme with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in appropriate Programme approved by PCI.

(d) BHMCT

Eligibility:

Passed Diploma examination in a Programme with at least 45% marks (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in appropriate Programme.

(e) BBA

Eligibility:

➤ Indian Students:

The candidates with Diploma in any stream of Management viz. 3 year after 10th or 2 years after 10+2 or two year vocational course after 10+2 or equivalent.

The candidates should have 50% marks or more in aggregate from a **recognized institute/ board**.

➤ International Students:

The candidates with Diploma in any stream of Management viz. 3 year after 10th or (2 years / 1 year) after 10+2.

The Secondary or Senior Secondary Certificate should be from a recognized Board or as per Association of Indian Universities (AIU) norms.

The Diploma done by students should be from a Government approved/recognized Board/University/Institution. The candidate should have secured at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.

In the case of students whose details of secondary or senior secondary Board's equivalence are not available in AIU booklet, special approval of the management/AIU needs to be obtained for accepting the educational qualifications.

(f) B.Sc. (IT)

Eligibility:

➤ Indian Students:

The candidates with Diploma in IT viz. 3 year after 10th or 2 years after 10+2 or two year vocational course from ITI after 10+2 or equivalent.

The candidates should have 50% marks or more in aggregate from a **recognized institute / board**.

➤ International Students:

- (i) The candidates with Diploma in any stream viz. 3 year after 10th or (2 years / 1 year) after 10+2.
- (ii) The Secondary or Senior Secondary Certificate should be from an approved/recognized Board or as per Association of Indian Universities (AIU) norms.
- (iii) The Diploma done by students should be from a Government recognized Board/University/Institution. The candidate should have secured at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.
- (iv) In the case of students whose details of secondary or senior secondary Board's equivalence are not available in AIU booklet, and no details are available for recognition of the certificate, special approval of the management/AIU needs to be obtained for accepting the educational qualifications.

(g) DIPLOMA (Engineering & Technology)

Eligibility:

Passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics/
Biology subject.

or

10+2 Science (with Mathematics as one of the Subject) or 10+2 Science with Technical
Vocational subject.

or

10th + (2 years ITI) with appropriate Trade in that order shall be eligible for admission to Second Year
Diploma Course(s) of appropriate Programme.
